

Aims of the project:

- to define a new interpretative model integrated based on the study of the *instrumentum domesticum*, of the legal sources and finally on the inscribed economy


Selected sample areas:

- ① Vesuvian Area


The excavation of the Department of History "Ettore Lepore", now Department of Humanities of the University "Federico II" in the area of *Cumae Forum*

The research aims to examine:

- Material and technique in clay production in Campania (especially in Cuman sites)
- Trade route of the different manufactures
- Organization of the work in the *ateliers* in the late republican and imperial period
- Significance of the craftmade production in the social and economic history of the Roman Campania.

The work plan

- **Collecting data**



- **Processing of data**

Research products:

- ⦿ Web site of the work program
- ⦿ *Corpus* of the historical sources
- ⦿ *Corpus* of the legal sources
- ⦿ *Corpus* of the epigraphic sources (stamps, graffiti and *tituli picti*).
- ⦿ *Corpus* of the ceramic shapes and of the respective fabrics.

The expected results:

- use the results of this research as a base for a new interdisciplinary project;
- the analysis of manufactured and agricultural products of Campania through the centuries;
- analysis of the organization of the handcraft work during the Roman empire
- comparison of this organization with other historical and geographical situations
